- ★ Elections
 - Nominations due January 2021
 - Ballots in March 2021
 - New Board takes effect June 1, 2021
 - **Vote** - Remain a two year board or extend it to a **three year term - YES**
- ★ Club Registration - \$35 for member clubs / \$75 for new clubs
- ★ Athlete Registration - \$35 for Level 1-6, \$15 for Level 7
- ★ Introduction to new registration procedures
- ★ Leotard ruling for 2020
- ★ Sanctions will be due to the State Director. New Forms located online under the Meet Director Tab. Competitions will not be placed on the schedule until all forms and payment have been received correctly. Once received, it will be posted within 24 hour.
 - The 2019-2020 Competition Schedule will be linked to GymJas. It will be up to date at all times. This is where the Judging Assigner will assign from, not from private emails.
 - Sanction prices will remain the same.
- ★ Athletes Age Groups will remain at the discretion of the host club.
 - **Vote** - Recommended age groups in handbook will be updated to reflect our enrollment in league. **YES**
- ★ All HS athletes are allowed to compete in XCEL, USAIGC, and the YMCA during the same season.

- ★ Competition Entry Costs will remain at \$45 for Level 1-6 and \$40 for Level 7. Team fees for Level 1-6 is \$15 per team. Level 7 has no team awards.
- ★ Spectator Gate Fees for standard competitions is max \$5.00 per adult, States Preview max \$5 and State max \$10.
 - **Vote** - Preview & State Championships spectator gate fee. States Preview \$10 &, State Championships \$10 YES
 - JOGA Competition Formats
 - JOGA Format
 - Vault - Level 1-3: 4 vaults, Level 4-6: 3 vaults
 - Bars - 1 ½ minutes per athlete BLOCKED
 - Beam - 1 ½ minutes per athlete 3 & 1 bump
 - Floor - 3 - 30 seconds turns 2 & 1 bump
 - Modified Capital Cup (max 76)
 - 2 vaults, 2 bars, 2 beam, 1 floor with bump in
 - Capital Cup (max 84)
 - 2 sets of identical equipment
 - No more than 64 athletes per session.
 - **Vote** - more than 64 at Preview & States to keep all the athletes/ages in same session - also see judges section YES
 - Competition Results are due back to Sara, via email in excel or csv format only, within 24 hours after the last session. If results are not in, a \$25 Late Fee will be applied. Those Late Fees will be payable to JOGA and sent your State Director.
- ★ Coaches Dress Code
 - Closed toe athletic shoe
 - Athletic Pants or Cargo Shorts - no jeans
 - T-shirt / Sweatshirt / Polo with gym logo.
 - Hats should not be worn on the competition floor
- ★ Score Inquiries should be directed to the Meet Ref at Preview or States. At standard competitions, one judge is told they are the head judge for the day. Ask during the Coaches Meeting who it is and the process before the competition starts.
- ★ Preview & State Meets Dates / Locations for Level 5 will be released on or before July 1, 2019. Preview & State Meets Dates / Locations for Level 1-4 & 7 will be released later.
- ★ Preview & State Sanction Fees
 - **Vote** - Remove fees for these meets. The league can pick up the expense to help host clubs. YES
 - Preview & State Championship Gifts.
 - **Vote** - optional or required from the host club. Required at States only!
 - The league charges \$10 per athlete at States to pay for the shirts & medals. This is the original price from 1999, however the cost of everything has gone up.
 - **Vote** - Raise it or keep it the same. Raise to \$15 YES
 Example-2019 state shirts were \$10, each medal was \$1.74

- Add / Delete skills - everyone seemed happy, we will update and name the "D" level release skills

★ Level 7

- **Vote** - to remove the full turn on beam and replace it with a half turn **YES**
- Host club must provide 1 score sheet per event. Judge is allowed to judge from notebook or each club can bring their own score sheets for the meet and keep them at the end of the rotation. No longer have to print copies of score sheets.

 - How to register
 - GymJas.com
 - Click on New Jersey
 - Click on JOGA
 - Click on Judging Assigning System
 - First Time users click on New User - enter your 6 digit NJSIAA number without the hyphen, make up a user id & password. It will be case sensitive!
- Judges mileage - **Vote** - keep everything the same (i.e., flat fee \$130 plus \$10 per hour sit fee) or add \$20 for 50 miles round trip & \$40 for 100 miles round trip **YES**
- Preview & State competitions should put the smallest sessions last on each day.

- Vote on skip level mobility- Movement for 2020-2021 will include skip level for any Level 6 athlete that scores a 30.5, three times during 2019/2020 season. Athletes will be forced to move to Level 4 the following season.
